enslaved man who argued before the Supreme Court for his freedom, but was ruled against in 1857, adding to tensions before the Civil War

abolitionist who led a raid on Harpers Ferry, adding to the South's pre-war concerns about anti-slavery movements

Kansas-Nebraska Act (1854)

#### **Description**

16th U.S. president, whose opposition to expanding slavery set off Southern secession; committed to preserving the Union and, later, ending slavery; assassinated April 14, 1865

#### **Description**

Union general in the

came up with the
Anaconda Plan to cut off
the South from supplies
and support

#### **Description**

former U.S. Army colonel from Virginia who commanded the Confederate Army; surrendered at Appomattox Court House April 9, 1865

by Civil War's end, commanded the Union Army; accepted Robert E. Lee's surrender at Appomattox Court House April 9, 1865
