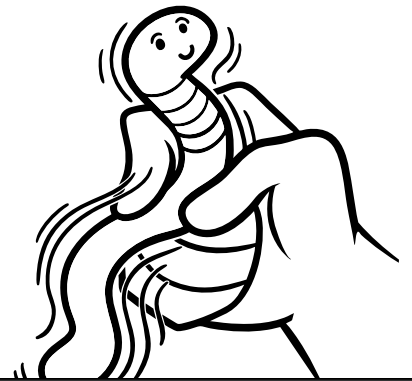


ELA Buzz
