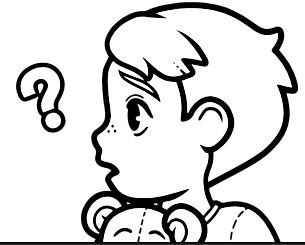
“I'm not tired! Can we stay up a little later?” Liam called back.
