Foxes don't fly! However, there is a bat called the flying fox. This bat gets its name from its pointy, foxlike face.

Flying foxes are the world's largest bats. With their wings open, some are 5 feet wide. That's as long as 5 rulers laid end to end!

They live in parts of Asia, Africa, and Australia. They gather in groups called colonies. Some colonies have thousands of members.
