Have you ever seen a monarch butterfly? They are bright orange and black. The colors tell predators the butterflies are poisonous.

Monarchs eat a plant called milkweed when they are caterpillars. Milkweed is toxic to many animals, but not monarchs. Eating it makes the caterpillars poisonous. The caterpillars form chrysalides on the milkweed plant. The toxic milkweed warns off predators until the adult butterflies come out. Adult butterflies eat milkweed too, so they stay poisonous.

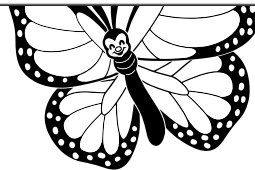
