There are many kinds of storms. The most deadly is a hurricane. Hurricanes form over warm oceans. They have heavy rains and very strong winds. Scientists use wind speeds to split hurricanes into groups called categories. The weakest hurricanes blow at least 74 miles per hour (mph). The strongest ones—Category 5—are 157 mph or more. Would you be surprised to learn they still aren't the fastest storms? The strongest tornadoes can break 300 mph!
