Humans have used energy sources like coal and gasoline for centuries. Many things you use today still need them! Those kinds of resources are nonrenewable. Once they're used up, that's it.

Luckily, many renewable energy sources exist too. Solar power uses photosensitive panels. Bits inside the panels move in the sun. That motion helps make electricity. Hydroelectric plants use running water to turn big turbines that make electricity. Windmills work a similar way, except wind does the turning.

Renewable energy can be expensive to make at first, but it's actually become cheaper than other sources over time! There's also another kind of savings. It's often very clean to make, so it doesn't cost the environment the way other sources do.
