The phrase “flower language” might sound silly or farfetched, but it’s not. It even works in more ways than one!

One way is what we use flowers to represent. You can say a lot with a single bouquet. You probably know red roses show love. Some rose colors show friendship or gratitude. Other flowers send more serious messages. Poppies show remembrance of the dead, especially soldiers. There are more recognized flower meanings than anyone can count.

The other way is more literal. Scientists now know plants talk to each other! Plants communicate about their health, threats, growing conditions, needing help, and more. They mostly send chemical signals through the air or their roots.
