Here is how you make a diagram of a sentence with a direct object:

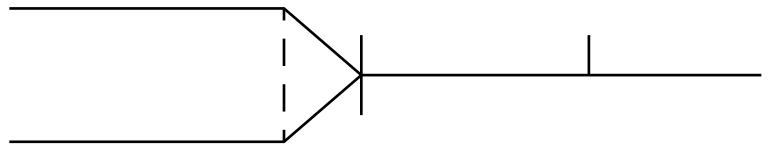
