

# Partial Quotients Division

Find an easy multiple of the divisor and subtract from the dividend. Repeat until the number is less than the divisor or you reach zero.

	<b>197r1</b>	
divisor — 4	789	multipliers
dividend —	-400	4 × 100
	389
