


Types of Triangles




An **equilateral triangle** has 3 equal sides. (An equilateral triangle is also an isosceles triangle.)




An isosceles triangle has 2 equal sides.





A scalene triangle has 3 sides, each with a different length.





A right triangle has exactly one right angle. (A right triangle may be isosceles or scalene.)

















