

# Range

The range is the difference between the smallest and largest number in a set.

Find the range of these numbers: 56, 54, 45, 50, 40, 42

**Step 1:** Find the smallest number in the set. **40**

**Step 2:** Find the largest number in the set. **56**

**Step 3:** Subtract the smallest number from the largest number to find the range.  **$56 - 40 = 16$**
