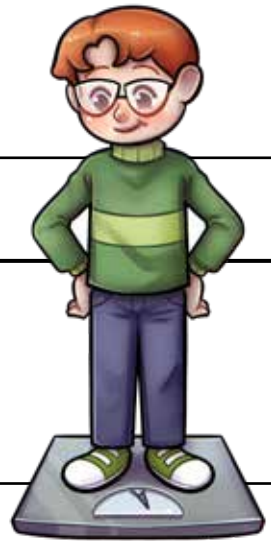

1 pound = 16 ounces

Abbreviation for pounds = lb

1 ton = 2,000 pounds

Abbreviation for ounces = oz.

Abbreviation for tons = T

examples: 3 lb = **48** oz.

3 T = **6,000** lb

16 oz. + 16 oz. + 16 oz. = 48 oz.

2,000 lb + 2,000 lb + 2,000 lb = 6,000 lb
