Step 1: Think of three animals you might see in a zoo. Write a haiku about each of them on the circles on the attached pages.

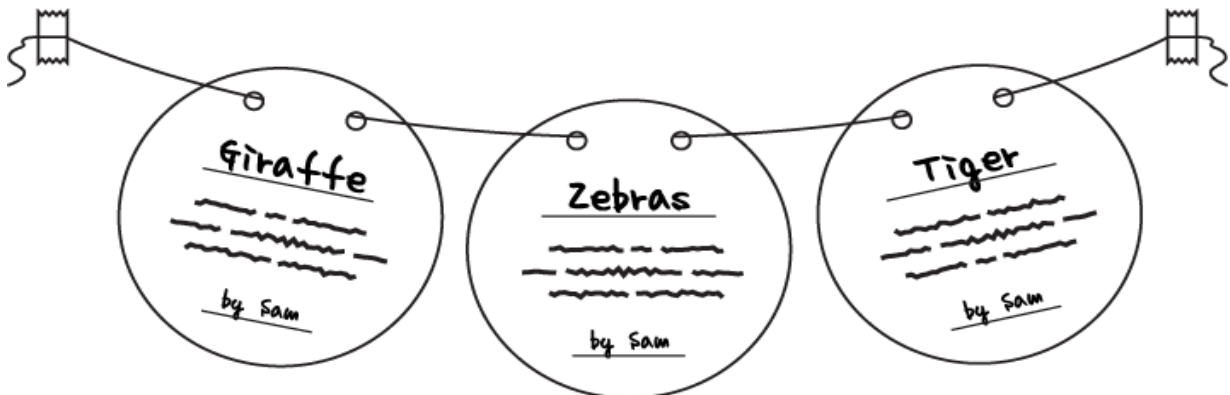
