About Your Spelling Words

This week's spelling words are all verbs that end with *-ed* or *-ing*. When a root word has a short vowel followed by a consonant, you usually double the final consonant before adding *-ed* or *-ing*.

examples: step + p + ing = stepping
flip + p + ed = flipped
