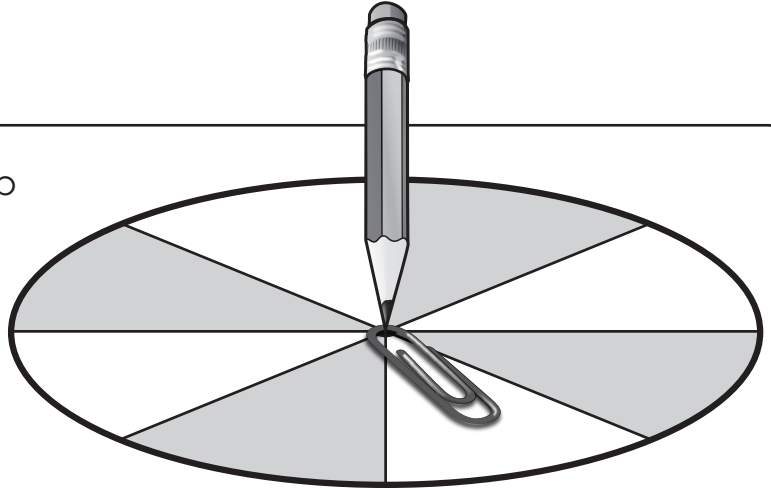

-ack Words Spinner

How to use the spinner

Place the large end of the paperclip so it is around the center dot of the spinner. Place the tip of a pencil on the center dot, making sure it is inside the paper clip.



There are countless games and activities you can do with this spinner. Here are a few ideas:

Spin, Read, Write (Small Groups)

Have students take turns spinning the spinner. Students read and write the words that they spin. (You can use the writing sheet on page 3 of this file for this activity.)

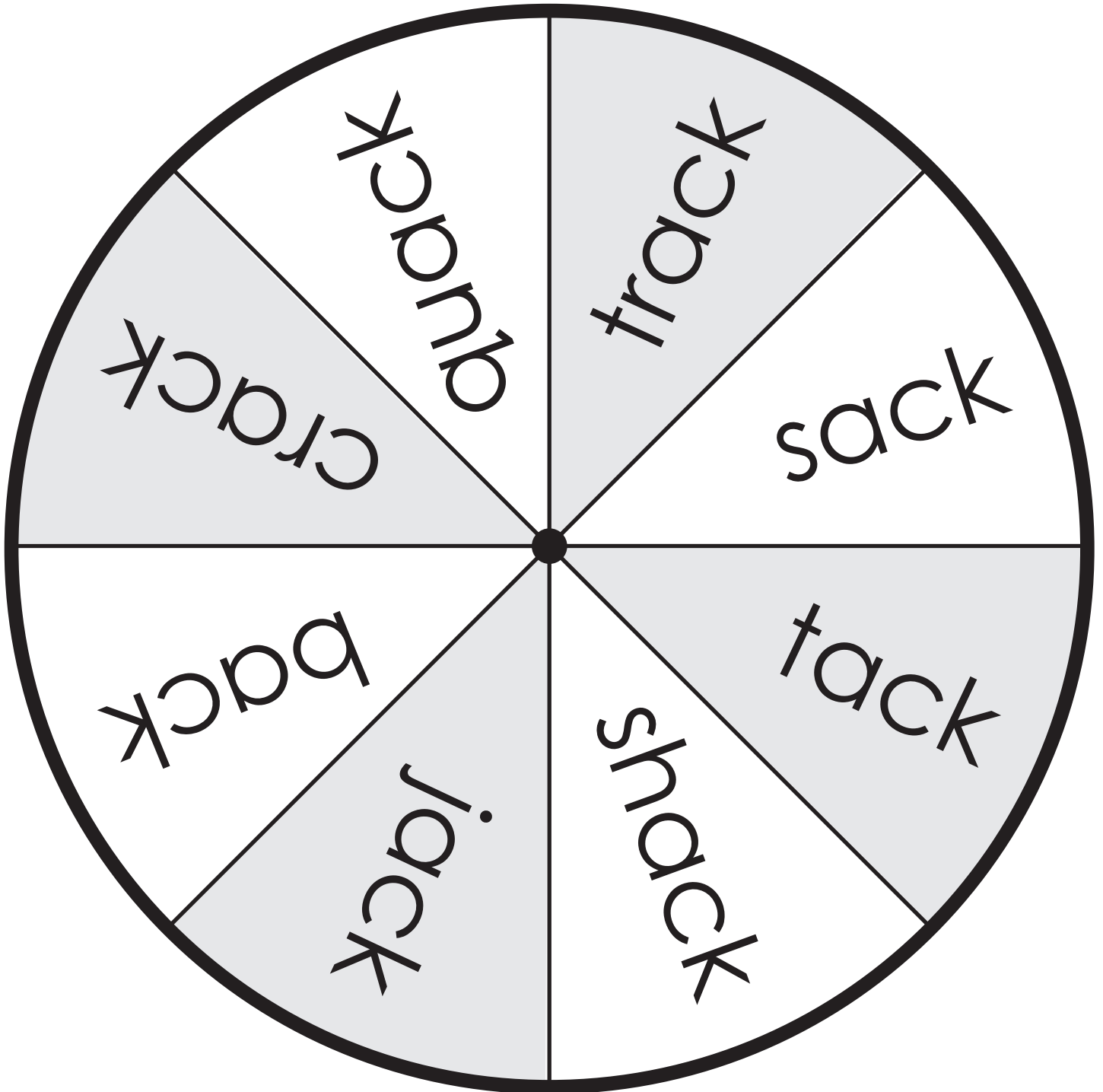
Spinner Memory Match (Small Groups or Pairs)

Write the words on flashcards (index cards) and flip them upside-down on the table. Students take turns spinning the spinner. They read the word, and try to find the corresponding flashcard. If the student finds the correct flashcard, he gets to keep it. If the student picks a card that does not match, he flips it back over. The student with the most words at the end of the game wins.

Spell and Spin. (Pairs)

Students work in pairs to play this game. Have one student sit with his back to the spinner. The other student spins a word and asks his partner to spell it. After three spins, they switch roles.
